## Expertization

To authenticate and certify the condition of Hawaiian stamps, HPS offers members an Expertization Service. The HPS Expertization Committee has certified over 3,300 Hawaiian philatelic items. In 2021 alone, 66 items were certified. A charge of \$24 per item is assessed by HPS. Following are the steps involved in the expertization process.

1. Preparation: Using special forms (imprinted heavy bond paper) provided by HPS on request, securely attach the item with mounting material that provides contrast for scanning and access by Committee members.
2. Mailing: Send Expertization form with item attached and \$24 payment per item to HPS using USPS Priority Mail envelope with insurance (assumed value), or similar international service. For return of item, enclose a self-addressed Priority Mail envelope with return postage and insurance cost.
3. Committee Action: Depending on submissions, Committee meets approximately every month. The submitted item attached to the HPS form is reviewed and commented upon as to its authenticity and condition. An HPS seal is embossed on Committee chairman's signature and scanned item.
4. Return Mail: HPS collects the completed Certificate and mails to HPS member in self-addressed, stamped, and insured Priority Mail envelope.
