701	0	10¢ Steamship stampless cover; Mate and Officer Nelson H. Keene of the Brig Nellie sent this cover from Cardenas, Cuba to his sister Mary in Rockville, Maine. Mate Keene's superb handwriting enabled him to keep Nellie's journal, in which he wrote the ship's previous mate, also the 2nd mate and the steward had been put in chains. The Nellie was destined either for Cork, Ireland or Falmouth, England with a cargo of "shugar and molasses".
